EMERALD SWIFT

Sceloporus malachiticus

ORIGIN: Emerald swifts are native to Central America, and range from Mexico south through Panama. They are terrestrial and naturally inhabit mountainous forests.

SIZE: Emerald swifts reach an average adult size of 7 to 8 inches. Males are typically slightly larger than females and much more brightly colored.

CAGING: Emerald swifts may be successfully kept in a variety of enclosures which retain humidity. A 20-gallon aquarium is large enough to house 1 male and three adult females.

SUBSTRATE: Emerald swifts can be kept on a variety of substrates including soil, mulch, and bark. The substrate should retain humidity and be easily cleaned. Gravel and aquarium pebbles are not recommended as they may be accidentally ingested.

TEMPERATURE: Emerald swifts should be provided with a thermal gradient ranging from 80°F at one end of the cage to 95°F at the other. This is easily achieved by placing a heat light at one end of the enclosure.

LIGHT: Emerald swifts require full-spectrum lighting to properly synthesize calcium and other vitamins. This can be provided with a variety of commercial light bulbs made for reptiles. A basking area must be provided with a heat lamp. Lights should be left on only during the day.

WATER: Emerald swifts should be provided with fresh, clean water at all times. Use a water dish which allows the lizard to submerge its entire body. In addition, the cage should be misted daily to maintain humidity levels above 60%.

DIET: Emerald swifts are insectivorous. They feed on a variety of commercially available feeder insects including mealworms, crickets, and wax worms. Prior to feeding, insects should be dusted with a vitamin and mineral supplement powder for reptiles.

- Hiding area such as cork bark or imitation rock
- Spray bottle

- Night light for nighttime viewing
- Live or artificial plants
- Decorative cage background
