P-60608 = Tommy “T” 82 is a home large enough for one small rabbit. It comes equipped with many necessities including a hide box, water bottle, hay manger, and food bin. The detachable wheels allow you to move this environment from room to room.



P-63042 = The 50L size bag of Carefresh offers the best value of our best bedding. Carefresh can absorb up to three times its weight, and can be vacuumed up for easy clean up or daily spot cleaning.



P-87898 = The Hi-Corner Litter Pan from Super Pet gives your pet a potty to call their own. Once litter trained in the cage, rabbits can have their litter pans placed out in your home to prevent accidents during out of the cage play time.



P-98797 = Oxbow has created a premium pet food for your rabbit, with foods that work well at all life stages. Make sure to look for the Bunny Basics 15/23 for your young pet.



P-50207 = The natural enzymes in Oxbow’s Papaya tablets help with digestion and can prevent hairballs in rabbits. With pineapple and papaya as its base, these tasty treats serve a purpose.



P-98804 = Oxbow’s Bunny Brome Hay is similar to Timothy Hay with a wider blade that appeals to rabbits. This high fiber, low protein hay should always be available to your pet. Try hiding favorite treats in your bunny’s hay to spark interest.
